The Home continues with weekly surveillance testing for COVID 19 of Residents and Staff. This week we had one staff member with a positive result who was fully vaccinated. We are thankful that the staff member only has mild symptoms at this time. None of our Residents are exhibiting any signs or symptoms of the virus.

We also want to thank all our families in friends with your continued patience with the visitation restrictions due to the COVID 19. As soon as the Home has any further guidance from the RI Department of Health, we will share that information with our residents, staff, families and friends.

The Home will continue with the scheduled visitation for 45 minutes. Remember that all visits need to be scheduled as the Home needs to be able to provide information to the RI DOH for contact tracing. The RI DOH has also provided guidance for Residents to schedule a family home visit. However, RI DOH are still recommending no visits of Residents to restaurants and other public places at this time.



Once again we thank you for your patience and understanding as we navigate through these challenging times. We remain optimistic with all your prayers and the newness that the Easter Season brings to the Home with the Spring weather and the blooming flowers and trees in the courtyard.
