The Home continues surveillance testing twice a week on Monday and Thursdays for COVID 19. The results of the rapid Point of care (POC) tests last Thursday for Staff and Residents were **NEGATIVE**. The results of a few of the PCR tests from last week are still pending. Testing was also completed yesterday.

Currently, no Staff or Residents are exhibiting any signs or symptoms of the virus. All Staff and Residents are fully vaccinated. Most Residents received the booster vaccine or received the Monoclonal antibody infusion. The clinical staff will continue to assess Staff and Residents for any symptoms.



Visitation may continue during the Christmas season as it is important for our community, residents and staff. However, the virus is highly contagious and visitors need to understand the risk involved with visiting during an active outbreak especially if you are not fully vaccinated. For this reason, we would advise limiting your visitation.

If you decide to visit, all visitors **MUST** wear face coverings at all times when upon entering the Home and when meeting with Residents. Only two visitors may visit at one time in the Resident's room. Please do not visit if you have any symptoms of COVID or have been exposed to
