The Home just received the results from the COVID 19 testing (PCR) completed on Thursday, December 30th. All Staff and Residents who tested were negative except for one staff member. Additionally, two staff members who had mild symptoms and/or recent exposure tested positive with a rapid test.



Last week, the RI DOH provided guidance that the Home could begin communal dining again. No Residents have tested positive for COVID 19 for the past two weeks. Activities will be limited to the units.

The surge of Covid 19 cases continues in the Providence county area and Rhode Island. Visitation may continue as it is very important for the Residents. However, the virus is highly contagious and visitors need to understand the risk involved with visiting and/or taking Residents out for a visit.

In addition, RI DOH has provided further guidance in regards to isolation and quarantining for Health Care Workers who have tested positive or been exposed. The course of isolation maybe limited to a five-day period depending on negative testing and vaccination status.
