Dear Jeanne Jugan Community,

Rhode Island continues to be at a high transmission rate for COVID 19. For this reason, COVID surveillance testing will be continuing for staff members who are not up-to-date with the COVID vaccine (UTD means that a person received the two vaccines and a booster) and also need to wear a N95 mask. Surveillance testing is not recommended for staff who are UTD with the COVID vaccine series.

The Home has been COVID free until March 24, when we were notified of two positive cases. Both persons have minimal symptoms. Only one of the persons had direct contact with Residents on the second and third floor units.

All of the Residents tested on Monday, March 21, were negative. We will be performing rapid tests on any Residents who had direct contact with any positive COVID cases.
